Such as Morotai is specialized in sector of fishing industry, manufactory, logistics and tourism. The strategic location of Morotai makes it potentially in terms of marketing, it is located in the way of Asia Pacific market means that Morotai have good chance for international market.

Galo Galo Island is one of the many islands in Morotai Regency with good tourism potential. this is because galogalo island has not been plundered by many people, so the natural properties possessed by nature are still very awake. galogalo island tourism potential is very good when developed, tourist spots such as beaches, underwater beauty to mangrove forests are still intact and untouched by human hands.

Galo galo island is located in the southern part of Morotai district. Galo Galo island is small island that separate with the main island of Morotai, it has to take 45 minutes by boat to get there. The total area of Galo galo island is about 15.000 M² (KEBTKE, 2019). The total population is 616, 330 male and 286 female in 126 household. The ration between

male and female is only 6:5 which means the male is not dominate. Then the role of women in development is so important.

In Galo Galo tourism development, there are local communities involved through Pokdarwis. Tourism Awareness Group (Pokdarwis) is an institution established by villagers whose members consist of tourism actors who have care and responsibility and act as a driver to create a conducive climate for the development of tourism in their village area. Tourism is expected to increase regional development and provide maximum benefits for the villagers.

Pokdarwis is a group that moves independently means that the development of tourism carried out in the village comes from the power of the village itself with all its potential. Pokdarwis must also develop itself independently or create development based on the potential of their creativity because they have the power to develop the village with all the resources they have. (Adji, 2018)

In the case of galogalo island, the potential possessed is a very beautiful nature of tourism with a very high selling value. thus what is needed by the local community is how to develop this into a useful value and benefit the surrounding village community. in this case, of course, high community participation is needed for boosting tourism. Due to the population between male and female is almost the same, the women participation and role's become one of the important thing.

Based on the explanation above, this paper will be focus to find how is the women's role for tourism development in Galo-Galo Island?


E. CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK

Those group has not similar number of members, it is depend on the needs. Besides that, there are also some activities that involve community participation such as making salted fish, selling army tag and local food. 


Figure 1 (Ko Bli Suda)

H. DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

Based on the concept of participation, Sofian I stated that the form of participation can be as an actor, controller, decision maker, advisor and/or development beneficiaries (Sofiani, 2009). In case of Tourism awareness of Galo Galo Island, there are many activities that involve women. From five groups, only two groups that is not include women which are diving and fisherman board.

Another three group in surveying group, woven and soap group, the women is involved in. especially in woven group, the full members are all women. In soap group, almost all members are women, even the instructor who teach how to do the soap also women. This is shows that women in those three group is involve as the actor and development beneficiaries. Otherwise they are also involve in decision making process as the decision maker to assign the price of their product.Besides the group, the activities that involve the women is selling local food. In this case the women are fully involve as an actor the one who do and sell the food.

So we can conclude that the women play important role in tourism development of Galo Galo Island. First, they are involve as the actor in three of the five group which is one of that is full members are women 12 people or 40 % of the total member. Second, women involve in the activity outside the group which is selling local food by cook. Third is women involve in guide the local people to make the soap or as the development beneficiary. Last as the decision maker because they are involve to set the price of the product.
